DENTAL IMPLANT OVERDENTURES: SURGICAL AND PROSTHETIC

The aim of this course is to allow learners to develop their professional knowledge, understanding and competence in the area of surgical implant placement protocols for removable full arch rehabilitation. Hands-on workshop will cover surgical protocols for implant overdentures and chairside pickup utilizing the Novaloc system.
